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## **Player Code of Conduct**

### **Adult Softball Code of Conduct**

McCall Parks and Rec. has established the following Adult Softball Code of Conduct to ensure that all individuals and teams participate in a safe and sportsmanlike manner. Providing a quality Adult Softball program requires the full cooperation of all managers, players, officials and spectators. Any demonstration(s) of misconduct may result in disciplinary action and can jeopardize your individual player and/or team eligibility to participate in the League.

### **Definitions:**

- The term "individual" includes: manager, player and/or spectator
- The term "official" includes: umpires, league director and/or softball coordinator, Rec. Aide
- The manager and entire team are responsible for the conduct of its individuals

### **Infractions and Penalties:**

- Minimum Penalty: Warning
- Maximum Penalty: Permanent Ban from McCall Adult Softball program
- Multiple violations of the Code of Conduct will result in an escalation of penalties

### **No Individual Shall:**

1. Demonstrate dissent by throwing gloves, hats, bats, balls, or any other forceful action.
2. Yell at an official or adult softball coordinator, for the decision reached by an official. (Calmly talk to the umpire about the call that was made at the appropriate time)
3. Use unnecessary rough tactics in the play of game.
4. Use abusive, offensive or intimidating language or gestures toward any official or individual on or off the playing field.
5. Use profane, obscene or vulgar language or gestures, in any manner, at any time, on or off the playing field.
6. Lay a hand upon, shove, strike, spit on/at or make unnecessary physical contact with an individual or official.
7. Make direct or implied threats, either verbally or physically toward any individual, official or their property.
8. Fail to leave the park when directed to do so by an official.
9. Damage, destroy or steal property of an individual, the League or the City.
10. Appear on the field of play or at the park, at any time, in an excessive intoxicated condition or under the influence of any other type of drug which might affect the individual's safety or the safety of others.
11. Consume or possess liquor in the dugouts.
12. Consume tobacco products within the Gold Glove Park area.
13. Leave behind excessive trash.
14. Demonstrate unsportsmanlike conduct
15. **No youth allowed on field during scheduled game times (including between innings or games)**
16. **No Alcohol allowed on the field at any time during scheduled game times.**
